- 6) Don't M\_\_\_\_\_.
- 7) Don't commit A\_\_\_\_\_
- 8) Don't S\_\_\_\_\_.
- 9) Don't L\_\_\_\_\_ about others.
- 10) Don't C\_\_\_\_\_.

**III.** The Ten Commandments are for S\_\_\_\_\_ L\_\_\_\_\_.

- They are not just R\_\_\_\_\_, but about R\_\_\_\_\_:
  - 1) With G\_\_\_\_\_.
  - 2) With P\_\_\_\_\_.

**IV.** The Ten Commandments were not given for S\_\_\_\_\_.

- The Law is G\_\_\_\_\_.
- The Law cannot S\_\_\_\_\_.
- The Law exposes our S\_\_\_\_\_.
- The Law leads us to C\_\_\_\_\_.
