### **I. We are Great SINNERS. (Micah 7:1-3)**

*“What shall we conclude then? Are we any better? Not at all! We have already made the charge that Jews and Gentiles alike are all under sin. .... for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God”, (Romans 3:9-13, 23)*

### **II. God is a Great SAVIOR. (Micah 7:18-20)**

*“Who is a God like you, who pardons sin and forgives the transgression of the remnant of his inheritance? You do not stay angry forever but delight to show mercy. (Micah 7:18)*

Micah places his trust in:

- The PERSON of God. (His Character)
- The PROMISES of God. (His Word)

### **III. WATCH and WAIT on the Lord. (7:7-9)**

*“But as for me, I watch in hope for the LORD, I wait for God my Savior; my God will hear me”. (Micah 7:7)*

This is the Old Testament version of TRUST and OBEY.  
*"For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.  
<sup>17</sup> For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through him". (John 3:16-17)*
